## Shawl for Alessia

Design : Martine Faucher

One day I found a beautiful yarn and made a beautiful shawl with it. The colors reminded me of a friend named Alessia. And the Shawl for Alessia was born ...

Crochet | skill level: EASY
Yarn:
$\checkmark 590$ yards ( 540 m ) of DK yarn Yarn Bee Caterina - color TANGOTOPIA (2 balls)

Hook: 4.5 mm (USA: Size 7) or hook size needed to obtain tension.


Gauge: 18 dc x 10 rows
Measurements: If you use the same yarn, the shawl will measure $24 \times 55$ inches (61x140cm).

## Abbreviations (US terminology):

ch = chain stitch
dc = double crochet
iris $=(2 \mathrm{dc}$, ch $1,2 \mathrm{dc})$
border iris = ( $2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{tc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ )
rem $=$ remaining
$\mathbf{s l} \mathbf{s t}=$ slip stitch
tc $=$ treble crochet


# Shawl for Alessia 

Design : Martine Faucher

## Instructions:

ch4. Join with sl st to $1^{\text {st }}$ ch to form a ring. Crochet row 1 into the ring.
Row 1: ch 5 (count as a tc and a ch), ( $3 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 2,3 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in ring. ch 1 , tc in ring. Turn. -3 dc on each side.

Row 2: ch 5 (count as a tc and a ch), 2 dc in ch sp, 1 dc in each of rem dc across the $1^{\text {st }}$ side, ( 2 dc , ch $2,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in ch- $2 \mathrm{sp}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$ in each of rem dc across the $2^{\text {nd }}$ side, ( $2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1, \mathrm{tc}$ ) in ch sp . Turn. - 7 dc on each side.

Row 3: repeat row 2 - 11 dc on each side.
Row 4: repeat row 2 - 15 dc on each side.
Row 5: repeat row $2-19 \mathrm{dc}$ on each side.
Row 6: repeat row 2 - 23 dc on each side.
Row 7: repeat row 2 - 27 dc on each side. (see image of row 7 at the end of instructions).
Row 8: ch 5 (count as a tc and a ch), iris in next ch sp, skip 3 dc , *iris in next dc, skip 3 dc * repeat * to * across $1^{\text {st }}$ side, (dc, 2 tc, ch 2,2 tc, dc) in ch-2 sp, skip 3 dc, *iris in next dc, skip 3 dc* repeat * to * across $2^{\text {nd }}$ side, (iris, ch, tc) in ch sp. Turn. -7 iris on each side, excluding the corner. (see image of row 8 at the end of instructions).

Row 9: ch 5 (count as a tc and a ch), dc in tc, *iris in ch sp of the next iris*, repeat * to * across $1^{\text {st }}$ side, iris in the next dc, skip 2 tc , ( $2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 2,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in ch-2 sp, skip 2 tc , iris in next dc, *iris in ch sp of the next iris*, repeat * to * across $2^{\text {nd }}$ side, ( $\mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{tc}$ ) in ch sp. Turn. - 8 iris on each side, excluding the corner. (see image of row 9 at the end of instructions).

Row 10: ch 5 (count as a tc and a ch), iris in next ch sp, *iris in ch sp of the next iris*, repeat * to * across $1^{\text {st }}$ side, ( $\mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{tc}, \mathrm{ch} 2,2 \mathrm{tc}, \mathrm{dc}$ ) in ch-2 sp, *iris in ch sp of the next iris*, repeat * to * across $2^{\text {nd }}$ side, (iris, ch, tc) in ch sp. Turn. - 9 iris on each side, excluding the corner. (see image of row 10 at the end of instructions).

Row 11: ch 5(count as a tc and a ch), 2 dc in ch sp, 1 dc in each of rem dc across the $1^{\text {st }}$ side, 1 dc in each of $\mathrm{tc},(2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 2,2 \mathrm{dc})$ in ch- $2 \mathrm{sp}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$ in each of tc, 1 dc in each of rem dc across the $2^{\text {nd }}$ side, ( $2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1, \mathrm{tc}$ ) in ch sp. Turn. -43 dc on each side.

Row 12: repeat row 2-47dc on each side.
Row 13: repeat row 2 - 51 dc on each side.
Row 14: repeat row 2 - 55 dc on each side.
Row 15: repeat row 2 - 59 dc on each side.
Row 16: repeat row 2 - 63 dc on each side.
Row 17: repeat row 2 - 67 dc on each side.
Row 18: repeat row 8-17 iris on each side, excluding the corner.
Row 19: repeat row 9 - 18 iris on each side, excluding the corner.
Row 20: repeat row 10-19 iris on each side, excluding the corner.
Row 21: repeat row 11 - 83 dc on each side.
Row 22: repeat row 2 - 87 dc on each side.
Row 23: repeat row 2 - 91 dc on each side.
Row 24: repeat row 2 - 95 dc on each side.
Row 25: repeat row 2 - 99 dc on each side.
Row 26: repeat row 2 - 103 dc on each side.
Row 27: repeat row 2 - 107 dc on each side.
Row 28: repeat row 8 - 27 iris on each side, excluding the corner.
Row 29: repeat row 9-28 iris on each side, excluding the corner.
Row 30: repeat row $10-29$ iris on each side, excluding the corner.
Row 31: repeat row 11-123 dc on each side.
Row 32: repeat row $2-127$ dc on each side.

Row 33: repeat row 2 - 131 dc on each side.
Row 34: repeat row 2 - 135 dc on each side.
Row 35: repeat row 2 - 139 dc on each side.
Row 36: repeat row 2 - 143 dc on each side.
Row 37: repeat row 2 - 147 dc on each side.
Row 38: repeat row 8 - 37 iris on each side, excluding the corner.
Row 39: repeat row 9 - 38 iris on each side, excluding the corner.
Row 40: repeat row $10-39$ iris on each side, excluding the corner.
Row 41: ch 5 (count as a tc and a ch), dc in tc, *border iris in ch sp of the next iris*, repeat * to * across $1^{\text {st }}$ side, border iris in the next dc, skip 2 tc, border iris in ch-2 sp, skip 2 tc, border iris in next dc, *border iris in ch sp of the next iris*, repeat * to * across $2^{\text {nd }}$ side, (dc, ch, tc) in ch sp. Cut yarn. -40 border iris on each side, excluding the corner.
